

### **Amaziah Delano** (1709-1790)

I wanted to get a brief mention about an ancestor of mine, Amaziah Delano, who is my 7th great-grandfather. Amaziah (Amasa) Delano was born August 9, 1709, in Duxbury, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, and lived his life in the Duxbury/North Yarmouth region of colonial New England. A great-grandson of early Plymouth immigrant Philippe (Philip) Delano, Amaziah married Ruth Sampson, and together they raised a family that included several children, among them Barzilla Delano, born in 1755.

During the American Revolution, Amaziah served as a Private in Capt. John Gray's company, Col. Jonathan Mitchel's regiment, enlisting July 7, 1779, and serving until September 12, 1779, for a total of 2 months and 6 days. His service took place during the Penobscot Expedition, and his roll was sworn at North Yarmouth, Cumberland County. Amaziah Delano died August 5, 1790, closing a long life that spanned from early colonial America to the birth of the United States.

I am especially fascinated by Amaziah's Revolutionary War service and the circumstances surrounding the battles and campaigns he took part in. Learning that he served during the Penobscot Expedition—a difficult and historically significant New England campaign—has opened the door to a deeper appreciation of his courage, sacrifice, and the turbulent world he lived in. I've found myself wanting to understand not only the military role he played, but also the broader story of his life, his family, and the legacy he left behind in the decades leading up to and following the American Revolution. I hope to continue researching his contributions, uncovering more records, stories, and historical context that can help us all better appreciate who he was. If anyone within the Kindred has additional insights, documentation, or family knowledge about Amaziah Delano, I would be genuinely grateful to learn more and help preserve and share his story.
