





From the Delano Kindred Website: PHILIPPE DE LANNOY – THE IMMIGRANT HIS LIFE & TIMES

Born in 1603 in Leiden, Holland, to French-speaking Protestant refugees from Flanders, Philippe de Lannoy grew up in a community shaped by faith, migration, and the textile trades of the Dutch Republic. As a young man, he followed his uncle, Francis Cooke, and other Separatists to America, sailing in 1621 aboard the Fortune to join the struggling settlement at Plymouth Colony. He arrived to a harsh first winter marked by shortages, hard labor, and the constant challenge of survival.

Over time, Philippe built a life on the frontier—farming, fishing, serving in the militia, and helping govern the growing community. He later settled in Duxbury, where he became a landowner, church member, and respected citizen. His story reflects the resilience and determination of early immigrants who helped lay the foundations of New England. NOW & THEN From the Duxbury Clipper

The Duxbury Clipper in the May 7, 2025, issue carried the following article on the Henry and Keziah Delano house on Cove Street in Duxbury. Cove Street is on the very eastern end of Philip Delano's 1637 land grant in Duxbury, so Henry and Keziah built their house on Philip's original property almost 200 years later. They later sold the house to Ezra "King Caesar" Weston, the well-known ship builder and shipping merchant who lived very near this Delano house. Many thanks to the Duxbury Rural & Historical Society for researching this article.

Cabinetmaker Henry S. Delano and his wife, Keziah (Ames), built the Cape-style house at 47 Cove St. in 1832.

Henry learned his trade in Boston before returning to Duxbury, where he and his brother Asa opened a shop on Cove Street. For a time, the brothers lived together at 10 Powder Point Ave. before Henry built his own home.

Henry and Keziah did not remain on Cove Street for long. In 1835, they sold the house to Ezra Weston and relocated to Easton. The Westons likely leased the house to shipyard laborers before selling it in 1867 to George and Emma (Paulding) Bates.

The circa 1900 photograph here is from the Bates tenure in the house.


