## 2023 Delano Kindred Annual Meeting/Reunion Registration Open!

The 2023 Delano Kindred Annual Meeting and Reunion is less than 10 weeks away! As reported in earlier newsletters, the 2023 DELANO KINDRED Annual Meeting and Reunion will be held in Duxbury, MA, August 4-6 at the Alden House Historic Site (AHHS). Although the Delano Kindred Annual Meeting itself will be separate, all other activities will be held jointly with the Alden Kindred and the Pilgrim Peter Brown Society on the AHHS grounds. As a result, we will not be needing a hotel to be a "home base".

Delano Kindred members must register on the Delano Kindred website to attend our Annual Meeting. registration for the Reunion part of the meeting can be done either via the Alden Kindred (if you are an Alden Kindred member) or preferably on the Delano Kindred website along with your Annual Meeting registration. This Annual Meeting and Reunion information is also all found on the Delano Kindred website and registration is now open. So far, we have 8 members and families signed up and we are expecting many more.

In addition to the registration itself, your registration fee includes everything except the Chowderfest, the Bradford House Breakfast, and the Bradford House Tour; those are optional events at a nominal additional cost.

The **registration fees** for the Annual Meeting and Reunion and optional events are: \$40.00 per person for Annual Meeting and Reunion (includes registration, group photo, and Saturday lunch)

\$20.00 per person for the Friday evening Chowderfest (beverages included) (optional)

\$15.00 per person for the Bradford House Breakfast (optional) \$5.00 per person for the Major John Bradford House tour (optional)

The presentation by Rev. Dr. W. Becket Soule on Saturday is titled "Prosecutions for Fornication in Plymouth Colony 1620-1694." But wait... here's the subtitle: "The Fast Life and Hard Times of Tom and Becky Delano" (a.k.a. Dr. Thomas Delano and Rebecca (Alden) Delano). You do not want to miss this one! While this agenda is very close to final, there are several adjustments to make. The biggest adjustment is that Alden Kindred is planning a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the major addition to the Alden Barn for the new conference center and museum at some point on Saturday. This will be exciting as the Delano Kindred and

its members have, to date, contributed over \$15,000 to this project which is by far the largest contribution from any Linage/Kindred organization.



Obituaries - David L. Grinnell

David Lawrence Grinnell passed quietly on Tuesday, April 18, 2023. He was born on September 17, 1943, to Clairmont and Mildred Grinnell of Newport, Rhode Island. He spent most of his life on Aquidneck Island with his family and friends. He graduated from Newport HS in 1962 and in 1966 he received his BS in Business Finance at Bryant College. He became the CFO at Codac for many years. He moved to Cranston RI in 2003 and in 2009, when he retired, moved to Palm Springs CA with his husband, Victor M Ranieri. He is survived by two children, his son, Nathan Grinnell of Georgia, two grandchildren, Ryder and Lila Grinnell also of Georgia, his daughter, Jodi Grinnell Brierly of Missouri, and his husband. He is also survived by a brother in Newport RI, Ronald Grinnell, and his wife Penelope. Two other brothers, Alfred and Roger Grinnell, predeceased him. David was a member of the SAR and many other genealogical groups. His rich ancestry has many kings and queens and even Charlemagne in it. He often held an office in several of these groups, either as treasurer or registrar.
